

# DBXL v3.3 DEPLOYMENT GUIDE

## OVERVIEW

Thank you for downloading DBXL v3.3! The goal of this document is to enumerate the main scenarios achievable with DBXL v3.3. Please read this document before installing DBXL v3.3. If you have questions about the scenarios below, need help determining which scenario is correct for you, or if your desired scenario is NOT covered in this document, please contact [support@qdabra.com](mailto:support@qdabra.com) for assistance.

## SATELLITE DEPLOYMENT

Deploy DBXL v3.3 to a server accessible locally over an intranet or remotely via the internet.

Perform the following steps:

1. Install and configure DBXL on a Windows Azure Virtual Machine (A3 recommended), or install and configure DBXL on a server exposed to your network
2. Modify your forms or Web pages to submit directly to the DBXL Web services

The main benefits of this scenario are

- No SharePoint required
- Supports submit from
  - o InfoPath forms
  - o Formotus forms
  - o Web pages

## ANONYMOUS WEB SERVICE

On the scenario where you have SharePoint installed and it is on a different server/domain from Azure, we recommend modifying your forms to submit to DBXL directly using the Anonymous web service. For this type of scenario, please follow the document [Submit to DBXL Anonymously using SubmitDocumentWithKey Method](#). This document provides detailed instructions on how to configure your forms to submit using Cloud Platforms/Services.

## UPGRADING FROM A PREVIOUS VERSION

In prior versions of SharePoint (for example, 2010), Qdabra supported an “Integrated” installation scenario with DBXL on the same server as SharePoint. Starting with SharePoint 2013, this “Integrated” scenario is no longer supported.

If you are migrating from an “Integrated” scenario please contact [Qdabra support](#) to schedule free upgrade assistance.

## INSTALLATION PACKAGE

When you download the DBXL Installation package, you should find the following contents:

- **Qdabra DBXL Server Edition.msi**
- **setup.exe** (executable)
- DBXL v3.3 documents:
  - This document – DBXL Deployment Guide.pdf
  - DBXL Installation Guide.pdf
  - DBXL Azure Installation Guide.pdf
  - DBXL Release Notes.pdf
  - Submit to DBXL Anonymously using SubmitDocumentWithKey.pdf

Once DBXL is installed, the DBXL start page will load in the browser and will contain a link to the Getting Started tutorial.
